Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to initiate appropriate enquiry against respondent No.6 who has mis-appropriate the funds and is not providing the record and not supplying the requisite documents despite the direction issued by the official respondents No.3 to 5 to the petitioner demanded under the provision of the Act and further to direct respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 05.09.2023 (Annexure P-4) and respondent No.6 may kindly be directed to provide the relevant documents as demanded by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 05.09.2023 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2, however, no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion to the officials respondents only.

Heard.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation before respondent No.3- i.e. District Development Panchayat Officer, Kapurthala within one week from today for the redressal of his grievance and thereafter, respondent No.3 would pass a speaking order on the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the representation.
