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**SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)**

1. By way of present petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought extension of parole from 04.11.2023, i.e., the date on which he is to surrender before the jail authorities as he is suffering from brain tumor and getting treatment from Cancer Centre, DMC, Ludhiana.

2. Pursuant to the previous order, State counsel has filed a certificate issued by the Dayanand Medical College & Hospital, Ludhiana, relevant extract of which is as under:-

**“TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

*This is to certify that patient Mr. Bharpur Singh, S/o Mr. Gurcharan Singh, Resident of Village Dodra, Tehsil Budhlada, Distt. Mansa, Punjab, Vide MRD No. 623830 is diagnosed case of Metastatic Renal Cell Cancer. He underwent left radical nephrectomy at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital on 22.11.2018. He was started on oral targeted therapy in December 2018 & was lost to follow for 2.5 years between January 2020 to August 2022.*

*He was admitted under Neurosurgery team in August 2022 with brain metastasis & underwent right frontoparietal craniotomy & tumor excision on 29.08 2023 followed by radiotherapy. He last attended Medical Oncology OPD on 10.11.2023 & was advised follow up after 3 months. As per the record of Medical Oncology OPD he was not advised bed rest during last consultation.*
