The present petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 18.07.2022, under Sections 324, 323, 326, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, Distt Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the complainant has opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner has not disclosed criminal history in the petition, whereas he is involved in FIR No.0071 dated 23.06.2020, under Sections 341, 324, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dorangla, Distt. Gurdaspur.
