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**VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)**

This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent College to send the correct mark-sheet of the petitioners to the respondent University and correction of final detailed marks certificate of the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel and learned counsel for respondent No.3 have jointly submitted that mark-sheet has already been corrected and given to the petitioners and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has admitted the said fact

but has stated that in the said process, the petitioners have missed out on two academic sessions and thus, prays that the petitioners be compensated. It is further submitted that for claiming compensation, liberty be granted to the petitioners to institute a civil suit/appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

In view of the same, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

It would be open to the petitioners to institute a civil suit or any other proceedings, in accordance with law, for claiming compensation.

It would also be open to all the parties concerned to raise all the pleas in the said case.
