The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.119 dated 21.11.2022 registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 323, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Bahawala, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

An affidavit dated 25.05.2023 by way of an affidavit of Azad Davinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural) Abohar, District Fazilka has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
