In the present petition, the claim of the petitioners is that they were entitled for regularization of their services as per the policy dated 18.06.2014 (Annexure P/1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly concedes that the said policy has already been set aside by the Division Bench of this Court while passing order in **CWP-17206-2014** titled as **Yogesh Tyagi and another vs. State of Haryana and others**, on 31.05.2018 and the matter is pending consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Keeping in view the fact that the policy under which the relief is being claimed by the petitioners has already been set aside by the Division Bench of this Court and the matter is pending consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the present petition is disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage with liberty to the petitioners either to revive the present petition or to file a fresh one seeking the similar relief in case any right subsists with the petitioners after the matter is decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
