The petitioner had filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to protect the live and liberty of the petitioner in view of the police reports Annexures P-2 and P-3.

A short reply by way of an affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, has been filed and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel submits that the inquiry was conducted by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala and threat perception report was obtained. The Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Batala, vide 391/D/DSP-City dated 15.05.2023 had submitted the threat perception report. After getting the said report, the PCR personnels were deployed near the residence of the petitioner and were directed to patrol the area near the house of the petitioner. It was found that the threat calls and

the videos calls were from Pakistan number and instructions were issued to the PCR personnels for ensuring the security of the petitioner. Apart from that, special instructions have been issued to the MHC Police Station City Batala to ascertain the security arrangements, ensuring the security of the petitioner by sending a special police party at his residence from time to time. Further, the inquiry officer has also recommended to depute one police personnel on temporary basis for the protection of live and liberty of the petitioner and a LR/ASI Gurdial Ram No. 1791/BTL has been deputed for the protection of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel further submits that all necessary steps have been taken to ensure that no harm is caused to the present petitioner.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
