Counsel for the petitioner submits that demand drafts bearing Nos.504342 dated 02.02.2023 and 426191 dated 07.02.2023, of Rs.2 lacs each have been handed over to the Investigating Officer and the learned State counsel submits that the Investigating Officer has further delivered the said demand drafts to the complainant.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.92 dated 11.11.2022 under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kheri Gandain, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 14.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on

instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 14.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
