Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, '*the Cr.P.C.*'), *inter alia*, for directing the official respondent to proceed in the criminal complaint dated 17.10.2023 (P-2) and take legal action against respondent Nos.4 to 9.

2. In pursuance of the previous order, Inspector Sumanjeet Singh, has apprised the Court that the parties have been challaned under Sections 107 & 151 of the Cr.P.C. Also stated that police is taking opinion from the concerned doctor regarding the injuries suffered during alleged occurrence.

3. In view of the above factual position, this Court is not inclined to entertain the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. and issue any mandate to the Investigating officer at this stage.

4. As a result thereof, there is no option except to dismiss the petition.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. Needless to say that if an occasion so arises, the petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy, as per law.
