The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 25.01.2023, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the Trial and he was to be admitted to interim bail.

The Court has been apprised that in view of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has since been admitted to interim bail by the Court of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur vide order dated 06.02.2023. A copy of the aforesaid order is taken on record as Mark 'A'. The learned counsel has also produced a copy of the receipt dated 03.02.2023 for depositing Rs.50,000/- in terms of the order dated 25.01.2023 passed by this Court. The same is taken on record as Mark 'B'.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The petitioner shall surrender his passport, if not already done so.

The present petition is disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial except for sufficient cause.
