1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to the respondents to reinstate her as a daily wage worker.

2. The petitioner joined the Syndicate Bank in May' 2018 and after merger of said bank with Canara Bank, the petitioner was never called upon by the respondent-bank. The petitioner visited respondent-bank and inquired about her appointment, however, no satisfactory reply was given. The petitioner even submitted representation to respondent bank, however, no action has been taken on the request of the petitioner. The respondent-bank has terminated the petitioner without assigning any reason.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the petitioner was working with respondents since 2018 and she has been terminated without any notice. She is a poor person and was working as 4th

class employee. The petitioner has made representation dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the respondent-bank, however, they are not looking into her grievance.

4. Without commenting upon merits of the case, the respondent-bank is directed to look into the representation of the petitioner and consider her case sympathetically.

Disposed of in aforesaid terms.
