LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant – husband challenging order dated 05.09.2019 passed by the learned Family Court, Jind whereby application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent – wife was disposed of while directing the appellant to deposit monthly maintenance allowance of ₹7,500/- by the 10th of each month.

Delay of 48 days in filing the present appeal was condoned on 05.03.2020. Appellant – husband was directed to file a specific affidavit reflecting income of the family, details of movable/immovable property and the amount, if any, received after removal from the service on or before the next date of hearing. Needful was not done. The matter was taken up after a long interregnum (due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19) and then on

16.09.2022 and then adjourned to enable the appellant to comply with order dated 05.03.2020.

However, learned counsel for the appellant submits that despite best efforts on his behalf to contact the appellant including sending of Registered letter, appellant has not come forward to file the requisite affidavit neither has he contacted him. Learned counsel pleads no instructions.

This appeal is, accordingly, dismissed for non-prosecution.
