Petitioner-Jagpreet Kaur has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer seeking directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to take action on the representation dated 14.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) as respondents No.5 and 6, in connivance with respondent No.7, accused in FIR No.54 dated 12.03.2021 registered under Section 451, 323, 427, 34 IPC at P.S. Khanna, City-II, Police District Khanna, destroyed/tampered with the electronic evidence in the form of CCTV footage with the intention of giving undue and unwarranted favour to the accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 14.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) to respondents No.2 and 3, but the same has not been decided till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be content if his representation is decided within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Jaiteshwar S. Bhandari, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, instant petition is ***disposed of*** with the direction to Respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahr, District Nawanshahr, to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and take appropriate action required as per law as early as possible, preferably within a period of *one month*.
