Prayer in this contempt petition is for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for willful disobedience and non-compliance of order dated 22.03.2022 passed in ***CWP No. 22319 of 2020.***

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide aforesaid order dated 22.03.2022, the State counsel has stated before the writ Court that disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner will be concluded within a period of next four weeks by passing an appropriate speaking order and thereafter, the claim of the petitioner for the release of pensionary benefits will also be undertaken and whatever the petitioner is found entitled for, will also be released to him within a further period of two months and the writ petition was accordingly disposed of.

The present contempt petition has been filed on 12.12.2022 and on a Court query whether the respondent-Deputy Commissioner, Ambala has complied with the aforesaid order or not, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a photocopy of order dated 20.04.2022, vide

which the necessary compliance of the aforesaid order has already been made. This order has not been attached with the petition intentionally, despite the fact that it was passed almost eight months prior to filing of the present petition.

Even otherwise, the petitioner has a remedy to challenge the order dated 20.04.2022, if the same is not in compliance with the order passed by the writ Court.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of.
