The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.431 dated 02.11.2019 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ambala City, Ambala.

Status report dated 11.10.2021 by way of an affidavit of Sh.Ram Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala Cantt has already been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sube Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 17.12.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.12.2019 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
