Through the present petition filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C.,
the petitioner seeks cancellation of anticipatory bail granted by this Court to
respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard and with their
able assistance the record of the case has also been perused.

Through a petition filed before this Court being CRM-M-38634-2019 – Ravi Inderpal Singh vs. State of Punjab and another,
respondent No.2 had sought anticipatory bail which plea of his was allowed
on 17.10.2022. Such order was passed after the recording respondent No.2's
undertaking that he shall not only clear the arrears of the school fee of both
his children but also continue to pay the same in the future.

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Even after the passage of over 05 months, respondent No.2 has not lived up to his afore undertaking as he has neither paid the arrears of school fee for his daughter nor paid her school fee from October 2022 onwards.

Today, when the matter came up for hearing this Court asked learned counsel for respondent No.2 to seek instructions as to whether he was still ready and willing to abide by his afore undertaking to which he outrightly refused.

The afore conduct of the petitioner is deprecated. He has also not lived up to his undertaking given to this Court as also failed to abide by one of the conditions on which he has been granted anticipatory bail.

In the light of the above, the present petition is allowed and resultantly, the anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 through the order of this Court dated 17.10.2022 passed in CRM-M-38634-2019 – Ravi Inderpal Singh vs. State of Punjab and another, is cancelled.
