AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 470 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.3,25,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants as per MACT award.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.3,25,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand only) in the respective names of all the appellants in the same proportion as awarded by MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 01.05.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

Appeal stands disposed of.
