The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 215 dated 22.12.2019, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Pau, Ludhiana.

At the outset, both the learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.2 have stated that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and even a separate petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR based upon compromise.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

It is directed that in case the petitioner is required for further investigation, then in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer on his furnishing

bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
