Status report by way of an affidavit dated 12.05.2023 of Shri Sucha Singh, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Branch & Criminal Intelligence, Amritsar Rural has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2 & 5, as per which husband of the petitioner No.1 is not wanted in any case and that they never conducted any raid at the house of the petitioners nor caused any kind of harassment to them.

Separate status report by way of an affidavit dated 23.05.2023 of Shri Nirmal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Central) Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 & 6, as per which no raid has been conducted at the house of petitioner No.1 - Indu Bala and that allegations of the petitioners qua alleged harassment and use of abusive language were found to be false.

Learned State counsel on behalf of respondents has also undertaken that no harassment to the petitioners shall be caused in any manner, in order to arrest the husband of petitioner No.1, in case he is wanted in any other case.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel on behalf of respondents and the reply submitted today, the present petition stands disposed of.
