Vide order dated 03.07.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-4881-2018, while allowing the writ petition, a mandamus was issued to the respondents to pay the minimum pay scale to the petitioner from the date of joining.

While issuing the aforesaid direction, it was observed that in terms of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court and instructions dated 03.11.2017, which were not denied in the written statement filed by the respondents, the relief was granted to the petitioner.

The affidavit filed by the Director, Women & Child Development Department, Haryana along with the judgment dated 15.03.2020 passed in LPA-1598-2019 is on record, wherein a clarification has been made that the claim of the petitioner is based on instructions dated 03.11.2017 and as per these instructions, the amount is payable w.e.f. 01.11.2017 and the said payment has already been made to the petitioner. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, no further action is called for and the present petition is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.
