1. This third petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

2. Heard.

3. Pursuant to order dated 13.07.2023 passed by this Court,
affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, District Sirsa has been filed on
behalf of respondent – State, wherein it has been *inter alia* submitted as
under:

14. That on 02.09.2023, the application filed under
Section 311 Cr.P.C. for re-examination of PW-9 E/ASI Paramjit

Singh was allowed and the case was adjourned for 05.09.2023.

On 05.09.2023, after re-examination of E/ASI Paramjit Singh and PW Jagmeet Singh as PW-14, the prosecution has already concluded it's evidence on 05.09.2023. Total 14 prosecution have been examined by the prosecution in this case. Now the case is pending for 18.09.2023 for recording the statements of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. The trial of the case is likely to be concluded in near future.

4. It is evident from the above that the trial is at an advance stage. This Court is therefore not inclined to accept the prayer made in the petition at this stage.
