Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.169 dated 3.10.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order of interim bail passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court and further that the matter stands compromised between the parties. State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Randhir Kumar, Assistant Commissioner of Police-IV, Model Town, Jalandhar. He on instructions from ASI Jagdish Lal submits

that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not

required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has admitted the facutm of compromise which is effected between the parties and further pleaded no objection if the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 15.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
