1. Short reply by way of affidavit of Talwinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dhuri, District Sangrur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State has been filed. The same is taken on record. Relevant part of the same reads as under:-

“xx xx xx

During enquiry ASI Sukhvir Singh recorded the statement of Sandeep Kaur (petitioner No.1). Wherein she stated that, "I got married to Gurtej Singh about 13 years ago and I had two children. My first child name is Khushpreet Singh age about 12 years and second child name is Sukhpal Kaur age about 8 years. I was living happily in my house, but my husband used to beat me and incite me to do wrong. He did not give me any money for household expenses. I used to do work at pencil packing store at Sangrur for almost two years where I was getting a salary of around 15000/- rupees. Here I became friends with Kamalpreet Singh and we both developed mutual relations. Then we both decided to live together. I have filed CRWP No. 10814 of 2023 in the Hon'ble Punjab and

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Haryana High Court regarding death threats from my husband Gurtej Singh and Piara Singh and sought protection of my life and that of Kamalpreet Singh, but so far there is no threat to our lives. I do not need any protection. CRWP filed by me should be sent in record. I don't want to go to my in-laws house." The said statement of Sandeep Kaur was corroborated by Kamalpreet Singh (petitioner No. 2). **True translated copy of statement of Sandeep Kaur (petitioner No.1) is annexed as Annexure R-1/T.** It is further submitted that Gurtej Singh son of Piara Singh (respondent No.4), Tarsem Singh and Tejinder Singh sons of Piara Singh (respondents No. 5 & 6) and Piara Singh s/o Kehar Singh (respondent No.7) have submitted their respective affidavits dated 16.11.2023, duly attested by Notary Public, Dhuri, in which they have stated in one voice that, the present petition has been filed by Sandeep Kaur and Kamalpreet Singh to harass them and their family. While Sandeep Kaur was never ill-treated by them or their family. Neither they nor their family ever beat Sandeep Kaur or interfered in her life nor will they threaten her."

2. In view of above, this Court finds that nothing survives in the present petition to adjudicate. However, State counsel submits that in case of any fresh apprehension raised by the petitioner, the same shall be assessed and dealt by the authorities, in accordance with law.

3. In view of above, present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Ordered accordingly.
