The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner and his aged wife unnecessarily on the basis of false complaints moved by respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.4 has filed false complaint against the petitioner and his family at Women Cell, Chotti Baradari, Patiala. Petitioner and his wife appear there and explained everything but they are harassing the petitioner by calling again and again.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, Senior D.A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that respondent No.4 is a daughter-in-law of the petitioner. There is a matrimonial dispute between the parties. Since, respondent No.4 has given complaint against the

petitioner before the Women Cell, therefore the petitioner has been called by respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Women, Patiala for conducting inquiry.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, no directions are required to be given in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
