The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.284 dated 06.04.2022 under Sections 120-B/379/411 IPC and Sections 6/32/33/42/52/59 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 registered at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.12.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 16.12.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 16.12.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
