By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have sought the quashing of the FIR bearing No.0139 dated 17.08.2022 registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 498-A, 406 & 120-B IPC as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sukhwant Singh from the afore-referred Police Station, apprises the Court that the investigation is still continuing and thus, the Challan has not yet been submitted in the Competent Court in connection with the criminal case under reference.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioners would file a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in the present petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

4. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 have no objection for the same.

5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
