1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of letters/notices dated 03.11.2022 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.6 and dated 29.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) issued by respondent No.5 initiating the departmental enquiry against the petitioner.

2. Learned State Counsel has referred to para 8 of written statement dated 08.10.2023 filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 6 to highlight the fact that prior to the stay granted by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 20.12.2022, the departmental proceedings were concluded and on 09.12.2022, the Inquiry Officer had submitted its report holding the petitioner guilty.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
