1. The present petition has been filed for initiating process against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of Constitution of India for willfully and deliberately disobeying the order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court dated 25.08.2023 (Anneuxre P-1) in CWP-4115-2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction was given to the respondent to pass appropriate order within a period of 6 weeks staring from 25.08.2023 which period has already expired but no final order has been passed by the respondent-authority for the grant of passport.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Neha Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel for Union of India accepts notice and submits that the matter is already under consideration and keeping in view certain holidays due to the festivities,

the order could not be passed and appropriate order will be passed by 30.11.2023.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. In case, the order as undertaken by the learned counsel for the respondent is not passed, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present petition and then, serious view will be taken against non-compliance of the undertaking given before this Court.
