It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had moved a representation dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, through postal receipts, Annexures P-5, apprehending danger to his life and liberty. But no action till date has been taken thereon.

3. He further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) in an expeditious manner.

After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
