1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners, in terms of the policy dated 01.10.2003.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are working as Beldar on daily wage basis since 1995 with the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad and have not considered thereafter under the various policies floated by the Government of Haryana i.e. 1996, 2003, 2007 and 2011.
3. It is only after the policy of 18.06.2014, the case of the petitioners was considered and they were regularized vide order dated 22.08.2014 (Annexure P-4) w.e.f. 01.07.2014 with a categorical stipulation that nothing would be given over and above of whatever payment has been given to them prior to the date of regularization i.e., 01.07.2014 and no claim in this regard would be admissible in future and in this regard they have to submit an affidavit attested by Executive

Magistrate 1st class. The petitioners served a legal notice dated 23.10.2023 (Annexure P-9), which has not been responded back by the respondent, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad so far.

4. This Court is amazed to see the present petition, which has been preferred in haste, wherein less than a month has gone admittedly, after the legal notice served on 23.10.2023 only. Hence, the petition stands dismissed being premature.

5. However, the petitioners will be at liberty to approach the Court again as and when the aforesaid legal notice dated 23.10.2023 (Annexure P-9) is decided by the respondents. To curtail the complexity in the matter, the respondents are directed that the said legal notice dated 23.10.2023 (Annexure P-9) be decided within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

6. In the aforesaid terms, petition stands disposed of.
