This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.114 dated 02.11.2022, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana, under Sections 452, 379-B (2), 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 16.12.2022, report dated 21.12.2022 of the trial Court has been received, according to which, the compromise is genuine, voluntary and free from coercion, pressure or threat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the private respondents were known to the petitioners and only a scuffle took place. Now that the parties have reached an amicable settlement, the FIR may be quashed.

In view of the report dated 21.12.2022 of the trial Court and on the basis of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the
