This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari to set aside the notification dated 1.5.2019 (Annexure P-8) issued by the concerned officials of the respondents according to which the students studying in the same school be allowed to get the benefit under Rule 134-A of the Haryana School Education Rules, 2003.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel are *ad idem* that Rule 134-A of the Haryana School Education Rules, 2003 (amended from time to time) has been omitted vide notification dated 28.3.2022 and with respect to the same, a copy of the letter issued by the Director, Elementary Education, Haryana affirming the said fact has been handed over. The said letter dated 1.8.2022 is taken on record and marked as Mark-A. It is further submitted that in view of the above said, present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances as well as the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
