Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing the respondents to release the amount of compensation along with all statutory benefits admissible to petitioner.

On 23.02.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“In pursuance of the previous order, an affidavit dated 22.02.2023 of Sh. Ajit Balaji Joshi, Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Panchkula on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side.

Perusal of para 6 of the aforesaid affidavit reveals that compensation redetermined under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 shall be disbursed to the petitioner on or before 31.03.2023.

Posted on 11.04.2023.”

Today, it is acknowledged by both sides that compensation in terms of Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 has already been paid.

In view of the above, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioner, does not press the petition any further.

Disposed off accordingly.
