MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (Oral)

By filing the instant revision-petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner-husband has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram (for short 'the Family Court') to expedite the proceedings in ***HMA petition bearing No.1285 of 2021***, as preferred by him against the respondent-wife under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act of 1955'), in a time bound manner as envisaged under Section 21-B of the said Act (*ibid*), while averring that it is pending since October, 2021.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner in the present revision petition, at the preliminary stage and have also perused the file carefully.

Keeping in view the provisions as contained in Section 21-B of the Act of 1955 as well as the fact that the above-referred petition is pending

adjudication for the last more than 02 (two) years and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, the revision-petition in hand is, hereby, disposed of with a direction to the concerned Family Court to conclude the trial proceedings in the said HMA petition and to decide the same, in accordance with law, at the earliest possible.
