Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.212 dated 28.12.2021, registered under Sections 341, 392, 394, 411, 34 IPC, at Police Station Central Sector-17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is behind bars since 28.12.2021. He submits that two co-accused have been granted bail in this case.

However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar has submitted that in all there are 14 prosecution witnesses, out of which 5 witnesses already stand examined and 6 witnesses have been given up and only 3 official witnesses remain to be examined. He submits that now the case is fixed for today itself.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, this Court does not find it appropriate to go into the merits of the case keeping in view the stage of the trial. The present petition is disposed of, however, the trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest.
