Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions for clubbing criminal complaints bearing No. 1449 of 2019 & No.1563 of 2019 titled as 'Main Pal Vs. Surinder Kumar', No.1460 of 2019 & No.1564 of 2019 titled as 'Kamal Kumar Vs. Surinder Kumar' (Annexures P-1 to P-4, respectively) which are pending in the Courts of learned JMIC, Abohar and criminal case titled as 'State Vs. Surinder Kumar' arising out of FIR No.72 dated 04.06.2020 under Sections 406/420 of IPC registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka pending in the Court of learned JMIC, Abohar and for setting aside the impugned order dated 12.07.2022 passed by the learned CJM, Fazilka, whereby, the application of the petitioner was dismissed.
