This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. seeking issuance of directions to constitute Special Investigation Team (SIT) of at least three Gazetted Officers for proper and fair investigation in FIR No. 259 dated 27.08.2020 under Sections 447, 427, 323, 506, 147, 149, 120-B, 188 IPC registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib as the property and life of the petitioner is involved and the investigation is a non-starter and respondents have failed to file final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C even after lapse of two years.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2, Sr. Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to consider the case and conclude the investigation in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.P. S. Grewal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has filed the reply, which is taken on record. He submits that as also mentioned in the reply, the investigation in the matter is in progress and continuous raids are being made to arrest the accused persons named in the FIR.

Considering the above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the matter and take action, if required, in accordance with law within a period of two months from today.
