1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to re-exercise the option under the HCS (ACP) Rules, 2016 keeping in view the letters written by the respondents themselves, copies of which have been appended with the present petition as Annexures P/2 & P/3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that once an opportunity has been given to re-exercise the option under the HCS (ACP) Rules 2016, the respondents are liable to extend the same as well to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits the the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 03.07.2023 (Annexure P/4), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time

bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said

representation.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 03.07.2023 (Annexure P/4) has been received in the office of respondent No.3 and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of further four weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
