1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner appeared in the departmental examination conducted by the Central Committee of Examinations, Government of Haryana but the result is not being declared, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the examination was conducted in the year 2019 and even after the expiry of four years, result is not being declared, which action of the respondents is unjustified.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 22.08.2023 (Annexure P/6) upon the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in case the legal notice dated 22.08.2023 (Annexure P/6) has been received by the respondents and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
