1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant of interim bail to him for three months in case FIR No.80 dated 15.06.2023 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the present case. He has been nominated as an accused on the basis of the disclosure statement made by co-accused Gurpreet Singh @ Meet. He further submits that Amandeep Kaur, wife of the petitioner is at advance stage of pregnancy and the expected date of delivery is 15.12.2023. He has also placed reliance on the medical records (Annexure P-2 to P-4), in this regard. He next contends that the parents of the petitioner are old, aged persons and are suffering from various ailments. Further, Shamsher Kaur, mother of the petitioner is also having 50% permanent disability, which is

apparent from the certificate (Annexure P-5). He next contends that there is no one at home to look after his wife and newly born child.

3. On the last date of hearing i.e. 16.11.2023, the learned State counsel had taken time to verify the documents (Annexures P-2 to P-4) and to ascertain the medical condition of the wife of the petitioner. In compliance of the said order, learned State counsel has placed on record the medical record of Amandeep Kaur, wife of the petitioner and the same is taken on record. As per the said certificate, Amandeep Kaur is having pregnancy of 34/35 weeks and is under treatment at Jiwan Nursing Home, Nabha and the expected date of delivery is 15.12.2023.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is allowed and the the petitioner is ordered to be released on temporary bail for a period of two months, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned. The petitioner shall be released from the concerned Jail at 5.00 p.m. on 24.11.2023 and he is directed to surrender at 10.00 a.m. on 25.01.2024.
