The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.337 dated 08.09.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula and all the consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise deed dated 08.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) arrived at, between the parties.

Vide order dated 19.12.2022 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 12.01.2023 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

Report dated 12.01.2023 has since been received from the learned SDJM, Kalka in pursuance of the direction of this Court. As per the report, compromise has indeed been effected between the parties and the same is

without any pressure or coercion and out of their free will. The trial Court has annexed the statements of the parties in original alongwith its report.

Learned State counsel also submits that there are no other accused other than the petitioners and respondents No.2 and 3 are the only aggrieved persons in the FIR in question.

In view of the report of the learned SDJM, Kalka and the principles laid down by the Apex Court in Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303, and also by the Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the instant petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed.

Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Court below.
