1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.118 dated 08.11.2022 registered under Sections 302, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1) seeking directions to the respondents to get the investigation conducted from a Senior Officer, as the petitioners claim harassment at the hands of respondents.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh submits that petitioners are not required in any offence, though, they are booked in FIR No.118 dated 08.11.2022 and there is no reason for the Police party to harass the petitioners.

3. The aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioners.
