On oral request made by counsel for the petitioner, the main petition is taken up today for hearing.

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 06.12.2022 vide which the operation of the impugned order dated 01.08.2022 passed by the District Magistrate, Gurugram ordering eviction of the petitioner, with a further direction to comply with the same within a period of one month was stayed.

Counsel for the State submits that the order dated 01.08.2022 already stands complied with within a period of one month thereafter whereas the order passed by this Court is of dated 06.12.2022. It is further submitted that when the police visited the house of the respondents, it was found locked and in the absence of any such specific order by the same Bench, asking for breaking open of the lock in order to comply with the said order, no contempt is made out.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded

that the petitioner has already moved an application before the Writ Bench for clarification of the order and the same is fixed for 06.07.2023.

Accordingly, no contempt is made out.

Dismissed.
