1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to the respondents to appoint the petitioner on compassionate basis.

Mr. Pranav Chadha, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, at the outset, submits that the matter of the petitioner is under consideration and he has been asked to submit pecuniary condition report of his family. As soon as the petitioner would submit the said report, the case of the petitioner would be considered and disposed of within three months.
