The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No.117 dated 26.06.2011 under Sections 336/34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C.Manjinder Singh, submits that in the instant case, cancellation report was submitted and the same has been accepted by the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, in terms of the order dated 12.07.2021 and as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
