Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.587 dated 18.11.2022 under Sections 3/ 4/ 5/ 6/ 7 of Prevention of Immoral Traffic Act, 1956 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 21.03.2023 of Mr. Ramesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQs, Ambala, on behalf of the respondent/State of Haryana is filed by the learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Vide order dated 19.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 19.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I.- Rajpal Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 19.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
