Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was appointed as a Driver with the Department of Excise and Taxation and had served upto 11.08.2021 however, the services of the petitioner were not extended despite the fact that the work of the post of Driver existed. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has already been registered with the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited but he is not being considered for appointment to the post of Driver and that too without any valid justification, hence, the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment on the post of Driver.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-4) but the same is still pending consideration

with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-4) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
