1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. *inter alia* is for directing the official respondent Nos.2 to 6 to conduct the inquiry against the respondent No.7.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer in the present petition for representations dated 24.06.2023 and 14.02.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) being considered by respondent No.2 or any other officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

3. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 6 only for the limited extent noticed above.

4. Ms. Ambika Sood, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 6 and waives service. Learned State counsel submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in Annexures

P-1 and P-2 would be gone into and addressed as per law.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or commenting thereon and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner and the statement made by learned State counsel, a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 – Director General of Police, Haryana, to dispose of the representations 24.06.2023 and 14.02.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) in accordance with law, within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
7. The petition is disposed of.
