[1] Keeping in view the decision given by this Bench, in CRM-M-58023-2023, titled Gautam Singal vs. Anuj Singal, decided on 30.11.2023, as also a judgment of the co-ordinate Bench of this Court passed in CRM-M-19553-2023, titled Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 24.04.2023, and also keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is challenging the order dated 25.08.2023 (Annexure P-4), passed during the pendency of a petition filed by the respondent herein under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. Remedy of appeal under Section 29 of the DV Act has not been availed. No such order is passed which is criminal in nature. As such, I am of the considered opinion that the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable.

[2] Consequently, the present petition is dismissed with the liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy as per law.

[3] Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
