None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. However, the learned counsel for the respondents submits that the matter has been rendered infructuous since the complaint filed by the petitioner has been withdrawn and the petitioner stands discharged. In support of her contention, she has referred to the order dated 17.12.2022 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Baba Bakala Sahib, whereby complaint titled **“Baljit Singh Versus Manpreet Kaur etc.”** bearing **CIS No. COMI/360/2013**, already stood dismissed as withdrawn and the accused having been discharged. This is the same complaint in which the summoning order (Annexure P-2) has been challenged by way of present petition. From

the above document, it is evident that the complaint has since been withdrawn and the accused stands discharged vide order dated 17.12.2022.

Therefore, the present petition stands disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
